



## LETTER OF INTENT

### On Sports Exchange & Cooperation between Chinese Taipei Paralympic Committee and Libyan Paralympic Committee

In a spirit of friendly relations between Chinese Taipei Paralympic Committee, hereinafter referred to as "NPC Chinese Taipei " and Libyan Paralympic Committee, hereinafter referred to as "NPC Libya" (both entities hereinafter to be referred to as "the parties"), the prospects for establishment of firmly cooperative relations between NPC Chinese Taipei and NPC Libya were discussed.

According to our wish for the development of sports for the disabled in Asia and Africa region in harmony with our one voice, the parties are confident of the great success for sports exchange and cooperation and agree that they will achieve their goals of this sports exchange and cooperation based on the fully active participation and support between two parties.

Desiring to further strengthen cooperative relations between two parties and to make this cooperation more productive and systematic one the two parties agreed, in principle, that they will activate and promote contacts between sports exchange and cooperation of the parties aimed at identifying common interests which would lead to establishing and implementing joint efforts for achievement of progress.

Under the agreement of both parties, they agree that the parties will make practical and concrete efforts to begin **Sports Training Camp and invite Sports Competition** between two parties that will be periodically held in each country and all the expenses for the stay in the other party will be covered by the inviting country. For the thorough preparation of these sports exchanges, further discussion and more detailed information might be followed.

They agree they will have sincere consideration for the participation of NPC Chinese Taipei delegates in **Libyan National Sports Games for the Disabled**, NPC Libya annually holds and operates as the biggest sports event.

They also agree to support the possibility of sports exchange and cooperation in particular for **establishment of closer relations and partnerships between the local sports organizations and member sports federations** in each party.

For the International Sports Cooperation, they will make earnest efforts to **build firmly cooperative relations between NPC Chinese Taipei and NPC Libya** for mutual benefits.

In order to enforce these common interests for sports exchange and cooperation such as establishment of training camp, holding the goodwill games and joint lecturing workshops as well as academic seminars, they agreed to consider a possibility of signing a cooperative agreement between two parties. The agreement on this letter of intent will become effective upon its signature by the parties and will be valid until the parties agree otherwise.

The present Letter of Intent was done and signed in Sports Affairs Council, Executive Yuan, Taiwan on 17<sup>th</sup> of August 2009 in two originals in English.
